

YOUNG WORKERS POLICY



McCabe Construction will ensure that young workers are protected from the risk of injury or illness arising from workplace hazardous. Special attention will be paid to the needs of young workers because they may lack experience and may not be familiar with workplace procedures.

McCabe Construction shall ensure young workers receive adequate information and training about work hazardous and safe work practices. All young workers will attend general industry induction, site-specific induction along with training in the following:

- Hazard identification & risk assessment
- Manual handling
- Work environment
- Powered and non-powered equipment
- Electrical hazards
- Hazardous substances

Supervisors shall ensure that all young persons are adequately trained and always work under adequate supervision.

:

- The supervisor will be required to observe and evaluate the competency of the young workers before they are allowed to use any power tools, explosive power tools, and pneumatic power.
- Young persons shall not be left alone to complete a task; they should be supervised at all times.
